3. <u>APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE JUNE 22, 2022 BOARD OF</u> <u>TRUSTEES MEETING</u>

President Gibson Vance stated that the minutes of the Board of Trustees meeting for June 22, 2022, had been transcribed and circulated prior to the meeting. He asked if there were any corrections, additions or deletions. There were none.

4. <u>FINANCIAL REPORT</u>

The ASB Foundation revenues in the 3rd quarter of the fiscal year were nearly unchanged from the previous year. Spending declined to nearly 28% over the past year as a result of the building renovations and legal fee expenditures last year. The foundation investment balances also saw a decline of 4.7% this year.

The Board of Bar Trustees voted to approve the FY2023 ASB Foundation budget. The high points of the budget will consist of unchanged revenues from the previous year and an anticipated spending increase of 13% due to the completion of the database modernization project, HVAC replacement, and the Fred Gray courtyard plans.

THE MOTION WAS SECONDED AND THE MINUTES, THE

FINANCIAL REPORT, AND THE FY23 BUDGET WERE APPROVED BY MAJORITY VOICE VOTE.
