ALABAMA LAWYER EDITORIAL BOARD PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The editor of The Alabama Lawyer shall be appointed annually by the President of the Alabama State Bar. During his or her tenure in office, the editor shall serve as chair of the board of editors. The associate editor shall report to the editor and shall serve as chair of the board of editors in the absence of the editor.

The board of editors is an advisory board and assists the editor in publishing The Alabama Lawyer and other publications assigned to it by the Board of Bar Commissioners. In accepting appointment to the board, each member shall consider it a personal responsibility to assure the contents of The Alabama Lawyer are interesting and enlightening to the Bar's membership.

The board shall reflect the diversity of the Alabama State Bar and shall provide opportunities for members of the Young Lawyers' Section to become involved in its publication, where appropriate.

The editor shall work closely with the designated staff liaison, who will assist the board in carrying out its purpose. The editor shall appoint person who shall be responsible for a written record of the board's actions.
